



Diving Well Rules

- Guest must be 48" tall to go off the diving board, or approved with the supervision of a certified staff member.
- Only divers are allowed in the diving well.
- 1 person allowed on the board at a time.
- Divers are only allowed 1 bounce before diving/jumping off the board.
- Back flips, back dives and spins are allowed, but if divers are too close to the board or pool edge they will be restricted to forward dives only.
- No goggles, mask or flotation devices allowed off diving board.
- Swim to the nearest ladder to exit the diving well after going off the diving board.
- There is a manufacturer's weight limit of 300 lbs. on the diving board.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the safety ropes.
- A weak swimmer may be required to complete a swim test in order to swim in the diving well.



Indoor Competition Lap Pool

- Use of the diving blocks is prohibited unless supervised by a certified staff member.
- No diving in water less than 5 feet deep.
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another person.
- No running, pushing, horseplay.
- Lifejackets are available upon request. Please see the front desk attendant or a lifeguard in the Natatorium to get fitted.
- Approved water toys are allowed. An updated approved toy list is available to read at the front desk in the Natatorium.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the lane lines.



Indoor Youth Play Pool

- The small slides, play structures and sprayers are intended for small children and toddlers under 48" tall.
- Children must be supervised by and adult 16 yrs. or older.
- Do not slide head-first. Feet first on back or bottom only.
- Slides are for downward movement only. No climbing or walking up the slide.
- No running, pushing, horseplay.
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another person.
- Lifejackets are available upon request. Please see the front desk attendant or a lifeguard in the Natatorium to get fitted.
- Approved water toys are allowed. An updated approved toy list is available to read at the front desk in the Natatorium.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the safety ropes.



Lazy River

- No Diving
- Guest must enter/exit at designated entry points
- Swimmers must be 48" or taller or supervised by an adult.
- Tubes are provided free of charge.
- Swimmers may or may not choose to use a tube, but please be courteous of others if not using a tube.
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another person.
- No standing or kneeling on a tube, 1 rider per tube.
- Tubes are to remain in the Lazy River only or on the tube stacks.
- No jumping or diving off pool separation walls, the tanning beach, the walking bridge or pool deck.
- Personal water noodles are allowed in the lazy river.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the safety ropes.



Multi-Purpose Outdoor Pool Area

- No Diving from the pool separation walls
- Zip line max weight limit is 250lbs.
- Only one person may ride the zip line at a time.
- A Lifeguard will direct patrons when they're allowed to ride on the zip line.
- Quickly exit the landing zone area after riding the zip line.
- Please try to keep all balls inside the multi-purpose pool area and avoid hitting other patrons.
- Approved water toys are allowed. An updated approved toy list is available to read at the front desk in the Natatorium.
- No dunking of patrons is allowed.
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another person.



Outdoor Youth Play Pool Area

- The slides, play structures and sprayers are intended for small children and toddlers under 48" tall.
- Children must be supervised by and adult 16 yrs. or older.
- Do not slide head-first. Feet first on back or bottom only.
- Slides are for downward movement only. No climbing or walking up the slide.
- No running, pushing, horseplay.
- No sitting or standing on the shoulders of another person.
- Lifejackets are available upon request. Please see the front desk attendant or a lifeguard in the Natatorium to get fitted.
- Approved water toys are allowed. An updated approved toy list is available to read at the front desk in the Natatorium.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the safety ropes.



Tower Slides

- Riders must be 48" in height.
- Riders must stand on back, feet first with arms across chest.
- No cotton t-shirts allowed on slides. Synthetic blends like rash guards are allowed.
- Riders must exit immediately upon coming to a full stop at the bottom of the slide.
- Riders must wait for a signal from the lifeguard to begin the ride.
- 1 rider per slide at a time. No chains!
- No water shoes, eye glasses or hats with metal adornment allowed on slides.
- Do not sit, stand or hang from the safety ropes.



Natatorium and Aquatic Park General Rules

- All Persons entering the aquatics center, including supervising adults, must register, and pay the appropriate fees.
- Proper swim attire is required at all times. All patrons must shower before entering the pool. No cut-offs, thongs or suits deemed inappropriate by management. Disposable or cloth diapers are prohibited in all pools. No clothing with suggestive or profane images or words. Swimwear with zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal ornamentation will not be allowed on the slides.
- Smoking or use of tobacco will not be permitted on city property.
- Guest should not play or loiter on water entries stairs/ramps or land entries such as park and bathrooms entries.
- People under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted.
- Coolers, Jugs, food, or drinks may not be brought into the park.
- Glass containers of any kind will not be permitted. You may bring a non-disposable water bottle into the park.
- No inflatables. Water toys are subject to the approval of management.
- A parent or adult 16 yrs. or older must supervise and accompany children 7 yrs. and under in the water and on the grounds at all times. 1 in-water adult is required for every 5 swimmers 7 yrs. Of age and under.
- No food is allowed outside of the concession area. Drinks are allowed on the pool deck, but not in the pool itself.
- Guest may exit and re-enter the park with the appropriate stamp/band.
- Guest 48" and above may ride the tower slides.
- No child over 36" will be allowed into the locker rooms of the opposite sex. A family changing room is available for your families group needs.
- Abusive or profane language is prohibited.
- No running at any time.
- Dunking or rough play is not allowed.
- No playing on lifeguard stands.
- Diving is only allowed in 7ft or deeper, or when a certified staff member approves.
- Playing on ladders, ramps or entry stair is not permitted.
- Front entries only into the pools. No back flips, back dives, spins etc. unless on the diving board under the supervision of a certified staff member.
- No suntan oils.
- Management reserves the right to restrict entry into the facility when full capacity is reached.
